Dear Sir, Madam,

We would like to inform you about our construction activities for Valley, located at Beethovenstraat and neighboring to sporting facilities of 'Goed Genoeg (AFC)' and highway A10, that will soon take place.

The removal of the sheet piles

In the coming period we will remove the sheet piles around the construction pit. The sheet piling will be pulled out of the ground through the use of a high frequency vibrating block. This method is necessary, because the piles are very fixed in the ground. Therefore it is not possible to use a vibration-free method. Unfortunately this means that the removal of the sheet piles can create noise and vibration nuisance for you. We will do our utmost to limit the nuisance. The removal of the sheet piles will take place during regular working hours from 7.00 to 19.00 'o'clock and consist of four stages.

Planned stages:

- 18th to 22nd of February : A10 side
- 4th to 15th March : part North
- 25th March to 5th April : part West
- 8th to 19th April : part South

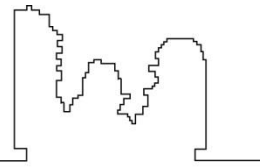
The work on the A10 side will take approximately 4 working days. The removal of the sheet piles at the north, west and south part each take approximately 6 days. We will communicate the exact dates through www.bcalley.nl.

Traffic measures

To ensure safety while removing the sheet piles at the Beethovenstraat, we will close off the bicycle lane on the east side several times for a short period of time. When the sheet pile shelf has been pulled out, it must be laid down flat. Due to the length of the shelves, it is necessary to close the bicycle lane for a few minutes while doing so. During the time the bicycle lane is closed off, cyclists can cross the street at the intersection with the Gustav Mahlerlaan, the crossover at the A10 or can wait until the bicycle lane is reopened. Traffic wardens are on site to give directions. The removal of the sheet piles near the Beethovenstraat will take place, outside of rush hours, in the following weeks:

- From the 4th to the 8th March : part North
- From the 25th to the 29th March : part West
- From the 8th to the 12th April : part South
